2nd Vehicle for Food Rescue

Did you know that each year PROP drivers pick up over 300,000 pounds of rescue food from local grocers? That's a lot of food—especially when PROP only had one van. Thanks to a generous donor, we were able to secure a second, much larger van last year. We can now say "yes" more often to picking up food throughout the city and we've more than doubled our hauling space, which means food gets to our distribution center much faster. And now that we don't have to ask volunteers to use their own vehicles, the number of drivers has risen 40%.

Bridging the Financial Gap

Since 2000, the cost of childcare has increased twice as fast as the average family income, according to Child Care Aware of America Minnesota. To address this issue, PROP launched a pilot program with a small group of families whose incomes are slightly above the eligibility level for state aid to determine if temporarily paying for childcare expenses would allow them to seek additional job skills training or get back into the workforce sooner. The pilot was encouraging and PROP will be expanding the program for the next fiscal year.

Free Mental Health Counseling Pilot Program

Thanks to a new grant, PROP piloted a partnership with Relate Counseling Center, a non-profit outpatient mental health center licensed by the state of Minnesota. For several hours each week, PROP clients have access to free on-site mental health counseling. "The folks I meet with here at PROP are dealing with the same stress as I see in private practice, but the intensity and multiple stressors they are dealing with are more pronounced. When you are struggling to feed your family, your car breaks down, and you are living on the edge, your physical and mental health is compromised," said Aaron, a licensed therapist with Relate Counseling Center. PROP and Relate are committed to help promote mental health as a critical component to overall wellness.

Snacks in School

It's pretty hard to learn when you're hungry. Last school year (Fall 2018) PROP, in conjunction with the Eden Prairie Schools, developed a formal 'Snacks in the School' pilot program. PROP works directly with each school's social worker or nurse to determine kids in need. Over the past 12 months, we have worked with seven Eden Prairie schools and provided snacks on a monthly basis. We've recently extended this program to college students at Hennepin Technical College.








