Position Responsibilities

Prepare and/or Assemble components according to SOP's by reading, understanding and following procedures.

Follow daily schedule for assembly.

Prepare and assemble components and materials as needed for daily schedule build.

Order raw materials where appropriate.

Set up equipment and tools for daily build.

Stage Product and label for baking. Load/Unload materials.

Document completed and incomplete balls or tubes and inserts.

Other duties as assigned.
