Notes for Families & Community Workers

- Meals are available at **no cost** for children and teens ages 18 and younger.

- No registration or ID is typically required.
- Meal times vary by location.
- Some locations serve breakfast, lunch, snacks, or “Super Power Boxes.”
- Food often must be eaten onsite depending on USDA site rules.
- Sites and schedules may change throughout the summer.
